

Corrigendum II of TENDER NO: REC/HR/TRG/Web Portal/2009-10)

The following modifications has been made to the Corrigendum of the above mentioned tender. All bidders are requested to take note of the same and submit their bid accordingly.

Sl.no 16. User Acceptance Testing (UAT) for sign off, will a separate set of m/cs is needed?

Ans. The clause 2.6 is modified as under :

There will be four servers. The application is assumed to be two tier architecture. The Web server and application for each portal will reside in one of 2 application servers and the Database of each of the portals in two other database servers. The O/s, Software and RDBMS to be supplied for optimal performance of the application with the server h/w. Vendor to ensure that application and database should be behind adequate security environment of Data Centre. In addition to that, in case of failure of any of the data base servers, the rest server shall be able to continue the operation of both the portals. The same is true for application servers also. Proper fallback arrangement has to be made for this purpose and also keeping in mind the SLA requirement.

The User Acceptance Testing can be conducted on these servers. However for future testing, separate instances may be created on these servers.

Note:

- Prices all inclusive of taxes including service tax. VAT, octroi and road permit. It is bidders responsibility to deliver at final destination, RECL may assist if required.
- Costs should be indicated clearly both in figures and words and any cutting/erasures/overwriting/deletion /modifications etc. shall be properly attested by the authorized signatory otherwise the bid is liable to be rejected.
- Under no circumstances any extra/additional taxes, duties, levies etc. shall be payable to the bidder by RECL unless such a tax, duty or levy has been newly introduced and notified by the Government of India.
- Prices should be indicated in Indian Rupees only.
- Calculations against each row as specified in the price schedule should be carried out carefully both for the total of each row and the Grand total. Furnishing of any miscalculation etc. shall be at the bidder's risk and cost and the bid may be liable for summary rejection.
- In case of a difference/discrepancy between prices quoted in words and/or figures the higher of the two shall prevail. Similarly, the total column will be derived from the rate quoted in unit*qty / Section – A and Section B and in case of any discrepancy with the quoted total figure, the derived total will be taken for computation of L1. Similarly for the Grand Total.
- Costs for all items must be quoted. If price for any line item is missing, then the highest price for the line item will be taken for the purpose of Bid Offer computation. However, the least price quoted against the line item in the bid process will be mentioned in the Purchase Order, if the bidder happens to be the L1 bidder. In case of any disagreement, the bid will be rejected.
- The prices shall be deemed to have been quoted by the bidder taking into consideration scope of work, schedule details and other clauses as specified in the tender document and as per tender terms and conditions and without any deviations of any form/sort/kind etc.
- The bidder shall be deemed to have noted and agreed to the right of RECL to order for superset/sub-set of the items and/or procuring the same and/or similar items from alternate and/or different sources at RECL discretion.
- Price of Optional items are not included in the bid offer for the purpose of L1 computation. However the bidder is committed to supply/deliver the items/services mentioned in the optional items as per discretion of REC.
- The prices are firm and to be valid during the entire duration of the project.
